#### **History**

Jagello 2000 was founded in Ostrava after the accession of Czech Republic and Poland into NATO, which the founders considered a great opportunity for enhancement of Czech-Polish relations. Propagation of the new-founded alliance was the main point of its existence during the first years.

The first NATO Day in Ostrava took place in 2001. In the same year natoaktual.cz commenced its function and the high school competition Aliante was organised for the first time. One year later Jagello 2000 became the operator of the NATO information centre and with these projects its activities reoriented to the Euro-Atlantic area.

Thanks to these projects Jagello 2000 prepared and executed the supporting programme of the November NATO summit in Prague. One year later it was intensively involved in the informational campaign for the Czech referendum about joining the European Union. By that Jagello 2000 established itself in the Czech environment and the Czech Ministry of Foreign Affairs chose the association as partner for implementation of projects in Serbia, Montenegro and Ukraine. Aim of these projects was to approximate the Czech Republic and allies in the process of integration into Euro-Atlantic structures.

The first national conference named Our Security Cannot Be Taken for Granted took place in 2014 at the occasion of the 15th anniversary of Czech Republic's accession to NATO. Due to the positive feedback from the participants and their demand for continuation the conference takes place annually and is strongly positioned in the portfolio.

Jagello 2000 capitalized on the experience when it was chosen as the co-organizer of the Čáslav Air Base Open Day. In November 2003, Jagello 2000 was chosen as representative of the Czech Republic in the Atlantic Treaty Association. Since 2009 the association is a member of the European Airshow Council.



# **Declaration**

An unprecedented common declaration of assurance of the defence of the Czech Republic was signed at the first conference held in 2014. The declaration was signed by chairmen of all the political parties (except the KSČM) represented in the Chamber of deputies of the Czech parliament. Based on this declaration the coalition parties then signed an agreement about assurance of defence of the Czech Republic where they committed to raise the defence expenditures of the country.



#### **Gala Dinner**

On the sidelines of the 78th UN General Assembly, we organised a gala Dinner on the occasion of the 30th anniversary of the establishment of the Czech Republic and the Slovak Republic and 30 years of countries' membership in United Nations. The gala dinner was co-hosted by H.E. Petr Pavel, President of the Czech Republic and H.E. Zuzana Čaputová, President of the Slovak Republic and attended by 8 Head of Delegations, several Ministers, Ambassadors, both countries' compatriots and American Friends.
